Were You Born In A Barn?

I chuckle when I see those "Precious Moments" nativity scenes. The moment of the Savior's entrance on the earth was anything but precious. He was not birthed in some sanitized nursery, but in the straw, among barnyard creatures. These were likely large pack animals; horses, donkeys and camels, which of course emit large animal sounds and smells. The "sign" the angels gave to the Shepherds was that they

could find the world's long awaited Messiah wrapped in clothes, and lying in a manger. Even then, babies were not lain in barnyard feeding bins lined with a layer of not-so-precious camel slobber. I'm glad he didn't wait. Still, it was a tough day to get the news. I had metastatic melanoma, and oh yes, Merry Christmas.

Yet during that difficult Christmas season, I was so touched and blessed when others thought of me in the midst of their celebrations. Testimony Time

We are featuring stories of those we serve who are fighting cancer. This month we share the amazing journey of **Toni K**, who is cancer free since April after battling Stage IV triple negative breast cancer. Truly the Lord has granted her this healing despite incredible odds against her. **Please pray for continued healing for Toni.**

Toni found Stronghold Ministry through Women of Hope, her cancer support group at Calvary Chapel in Melbourne, Florida. She wrote: "Thanks for doing the work that you do.....I know our group leader enjoys your website...she forwards us stuff all the time...so I signed up myself....glad to be on board."

Toni's story: "I was diagnosed with Stage 4 metastatic breast cancer in Dec 2007. It had spread to spine, hips, femurs, skull and liver, with spinal stenosis at T10-12. I spent 16 days in the hospital getting emergency radiation to shrink the tumors squeezing my spinal cord. I was unable to walk or sit...all I could do was lay perfectly flat. I slowly got strong enough to come home, and start chemotherapy in Jan 2008. Since then I've had 3 rounds of different chemo meds, as while on chemo my tumors would go away, but would return when I stopped che-



motherapy. I've had a total of 42 rounds of chemo and weeks of radiation. I started attending church in Jan, 2009. I rededicated my life to Christ that first day back and was baptized in June. In April 2010, I attended an elder prayer service and had the elders anoint me with oil and say prayers of healing over me*. The next week, I got my 1st clean PETSCAN without being on continual chemo. Since then I've had 3 clean PETSCANS, and have been off chemo for 7 months now. God has heard my cries and rescued me....I now volunteer in 2 different chemo rooms, working with patients still in treatment. I documented my journey in a scrapbook that I share with the patients to show them that things will get better and to hang in there, and keep the faith. That God is still in the Miracle Business...and he does hear us. Is God awesome or what?"

*The prayer service Toni refers to here is based on James 5:14-15, "Is anyone among you sick? Then he must call for the elders of the church and they are to pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord; and the prayer offered in faith will restore the one who is sick, and the Lord will raise him up, and if he has committed sins, they will be forgiven him." Stronghold Ministry strongly recommends cancer patients and all who are sick to follow these instructions for prayer and healing. We believe the Lord will do more miracles if we simply ask in the way HE guides us to pray!
