We are featuring the stories of warriors and caretakers we serve. This month we share a note from **JoAnne**. She has been battling breast cancer that spread to her liver. She recently received cyber knife radiation treatments to the liver area and is doing very well now. We will share JoAnne's full story in a future issue of **The Exchanger**. Recently JoAnne wrote about our weekly devotional, **In His Grip**:

Dear Joe and Terri,

Well, your devotional has done it again! By that I mean, your words and God speaking through you has spoken directly to a specific issue I am dealing with. And it goes without saying, that your devotional helps me so very much. Recently I too came to know my "inner brat," as 2 days prior to my scheduled hysterectomy I came down with a second staph/strep infection in my left breast. (The first episode happened over Thanksgiving.) They immediately hospitalized me on Valentine's Day for six days and, of course, canceled my surgery. I was so "poor, pitiful me," and questioned why this had to happen, AGAIN? Since be-



ing discharged and at home on IV antibiotics, I have had much time in bed to think, pray and read including your devotionals. My attitude is so much better. I know there is a reason, and I just have to trust in the Lord that He knows what's best. Always! Thank you for playing a valuable role in my getting to a place of peace over this recent setback. It just amazes me how God speaks to me through you!


